According to Khoiroes et al., in Wael & Hasanudin, 2020) Speaking is a very important skill for every human being to master in order to communicate well so that any information conveyed or received can be understood by other individuals or groups (Lisnawati, 2023). This method can help students develop English language skills more quickly and effectively.

In the context of English learning, the Modeling the Way method has several steps in carrying out learning, namely

- a. Demonstration: The teacher or learner who acts as a model will provide examples of correct use of English. They will show you how to pronounce words, construct sentences, or use grammar correctly.
- b. Imitation: After the demonstration, learners will be asked to imitate and repeat what they have seen and heard from the model. This helps them strengthen their understanding and correct use of English.
- c. Practice: After imitation, learners will be given the opportunity to practiceusingEnglishinrelevantcontexts.Theywillbegiven

assignments or activities that will allow them to apply what they have learned.

The Modeling the Way method is effective because it allows students to see and hear examples of correct use of English. This helps them gain a better understanding of grammar, vocabulary and proper pronunciation(Santoso, 2020).

Thus, choosing an effective learning method is very important to achieve optimal learning results.

2.4 "ModellingtheWay"ModelsinLanguageLearning

The Way Modeling Method is a teaching method developed by Mel Silberman, a person who is competent in the field of educational psychology. This method is one of 101teaching strategies. A method that focuses on a student's ability to develop the potential that exists within him. Because students are required to play roles according to the material taught. Modeling the Way is a method that can provide students with the opportunity to practice specific skills learned in class through demonstrations(Hamima, 2022). In learning, methods are very necessary in schools, especially for classroom learning. That a learning model is a plan or pattern that is used as a guide in planning classroom learning or tutorial learning. The more appropriate the method the teacher uses in teaching, the more effective it is expected to be in achieving learning goals.

The Modeling the Way method is a method that makes students more active in learning(Kartini, 2024). Students become braver and more confident to practice something and are not afraid, students actively respond, increase awareness of responsibility for the tasks given, and students experience existing skills. practiced directly. Hisyam Zainiet al, in their book on active learning strategies, reveal that the Modeling the Way method provides students with the opportunity to practice the special skills they have in front of the class through demonstrations. (Sukmawati, 2020).

Learning English vocabulary is an important initial stage in learning and masteringthelanguage.InEnglish,vocabularyconsistsofadjectives,verbs,

Vocabulary

The relationship between learning models and increasing English vocabulary is that research shows that vocabulary(Fandi, 2014). Learning strategies play an important role in vocabulary knowledge among learners of English as a foreign language. And in every learning process teachers are required to use learning methods so that learning can run optimally (Hamima, 2022).

This suggests that the specific strategies used to learn vocabulary can have a direct impact on the depth of vocabulary knowledge. Additionally, vocabulary instruction should aim to engage students in thinking actively about word meanings, relationshipsbetweenwords, and how words can be used in different

situations. This type of rich, in-depth instruction is most likely to impact comprehension, suggesting that depth of vocabulary instruction can have a significant impact on vocabulary learning(Hafid, 2023). Overall, research suggests that the specific vocabulary learning strategies used, as well as the depth and richness of vocabulary instruction, can have a direct impact on the depth of English vocabulary knowledge among learners.

2.8 EnglishLearninginMTSTa'dibAl-MualliminAl -Islamy

Teachingandlearningactivities are anobligation carried out deliberately by a teacher or tutor, to provide lessons and education to students or learners. Teachers who teach and students who learn. The combination of these two human elements gives birth to educational interactions using materials as the medium. All teaching components are played optimally and effectively in order to achieve the teaching objectives that have been set before the teaching is carried out. In teaching and learning activities there must be two-way communication between teachers and students so that the teaching and learning process will be directed towards achieving learning goals. So far, the learning carried out has only been centered on the teacher as a learning resource, not student-centered, so the teacher will dominate the learning process in the classroom while the students only passively listen. Here the teacher acts as a facilitator and is not visible in the learning process. Teachers should be able to master basic competencies which are expected toestablish two-way communication so that learning objectives can be achieved optimally.

Likewise in learning English vocabulary atMTS Ta'dib Al – Muallimin Al – Islamy class III. The teacher first prepares the learning materials that will be given to students. The Modeling the Way method used by teachers to carry out the English language learning process is by first explaining the material to be studied, after that some vocabulary material is said together several times until the child'spronunciation is fluent, then the teacher spells. the vocabulary learned is on the blackboard and spelled together by the students, then the teacher erases the writingon the blackboard after observing the spelling by the students, then the teacher gives individual assignments to the students to work on writing the spelling of the English vocabulary and its meanings that have been spelled on the blackboard and observed, so that this makes children know how to write English vocabulary by spelling the vocabulary.
